


Please carefully read the following and sign below:

- While you are on PSA property and on the water, you will be courteous and respectful to other sailors, instructors and adult volunteers. Absolutely no bad language, insults, or talking back to instructors and volunteers will be tolerated.
- You will follow the rules of your instructors, on **and** off the water.
- Lifejackets and shoes (no flip-flops or sandals) are **mandatory** on the boats and piers.
- The grounds, boats and equipment used in our Junior Sail program are the property of PSA and its members. You will treat this property with respect. Intentional misuse of the Junior Sail boats and equipment will result in suspension of your sailing privileges.
- You will not intentionally capsize/swamp your boat unless directed to do so by your instructor.
- Moored and docked boats are private property. You will not board any boat without permission to come aboard.
- Kayaks and chase boats are the property of the Junior Sail Program (or lent to the program) for
 instructional use only. After instructional hours, kayaks and chase boats may not be used without the
 owner's permission and are to be used under adult supervision only. Permission must be obtained before
 each use of a kayak. All kayaks and paddles are to be properly secured on the dock upon return.
- No swimming unless under the direct supervision of an adult. No rough play in the water, or you will be asked to get out.
- During Junior Sail hours (8:30am 4:30pm), use of personal electronic devices is prohibited.
- Quiet on the docks will be observed after 9pm. The Clubhouse may be used for evening activities until 11pm.
- There will be consequences for breaking the rules, ranging from verbal warnings, to temporary loss of sailing privileges, to expulsion from the program without a refund.
