Our Insignia and Our Name - Potapskut

A white explorer's Indian guide from the Eastern Shore, Southern Maryland or Virginia was probably responsible for the name Patapsco, which came into popular use about 1640.

Its roots were POTA (to jut out), PSK (ledge of rock), UT (at) Potapsk-ut thus meant "at the jutting ledge of rock", referring originally to those famed land-marks, the white limestone rocks at the common juncture of the River and our Rock Creek with the Bay; by extension these identified the entire River.

Thus our Association identifies itself simultaneously with the nearby River and the equally close White Rocks.
